#### Dear Parents/Carers/Students

Another term nearly done – another term closer! I hope this letter finds you well for the coming term ahead and the Summer Examinations. I am writing to you with a summary of important information and dates for the remainder of this term and to highlight the support available for our Year 11 cohort.

## (1) Core Pre-Public Examination (PPE) Day 2 – Tuesday 19 & Wednesday 20 March 2024

Tuesday and Wednesday of this week are another opportunity to undertake Core Subject Examinations. This will be held within normal lesson time over the course of two days. Students will be under normal examination conditions and where possible the class teacher and an invigilator will be present to administer the examinations.

Students should arrive at school at normal time **for line-up at 0840.** They will attend registration and then go to their normal classrooms with their normal teachers to take the examination. Students should enter classrooms when instructed and follow both teacher and invigilator directions. Prompt and orderly entrances to their rooms will ensure completion in time for break and lunch on each day.

#### Students will sit:

**Tuesday 19 March:** 

- Periods 1 & 2 Science Paper go to usual Period 1 Science in normal room
- Periods 3 & 4 English Language Paper go to usual Period 3 English room after break

#### Wednesday 20 March:

• **Periods 3 & 4 – Maths Paper** – go to their usual Maths rooms straight after break. A member of the English faculty and an Invigilator will administer the exam during Period three and then their usual Maths teacher will swap during Period 4.



Students are aware of what is being examined and have been preparing in lessons. The examinations are no less serious than if undertaken in the Sports Hall. Students should have the correct equipment for each examination.

These exams will be externally marked with feedback informing the final interventions after Easter.

As a reminder: Students should ensure they have the correct equipment for each examination the evening beforehand.

- **Full clear plastic pencil case** (pens, pencils, ruler, eraser, sharpener, Maths equipment e.g. calculator, protractor)
- Water (no other drinks are permitted, and water must be in an un-labelled bottle)
- Turn off phones before the exam
- **Revision materials** for before the examinations

## (2) Positively You – Revision Buster - Session 21 March 2024

We are providing an Exam Revision Buster Session this Thursday. The whole cohort will undertake the two hour session during their **PE lessons on Thursday** - half the cohort in Periods 1 & 2 and the other half in Periods 3 & 4. The session will take place in the Main Hall and is being provided by a company called Positively You. It will cover different revision techniques and tips for examinations in an engaging and work focused way. Students can bring a piece of work they need to revise and get practical advice on how to do so.
