Ofsted inspection – 19 and 20 April 2023

Hampstead School welcomed Ofsted inspectors into school in April 2023. The inspectorate have just provided us with the final report; you can access it via the link below.

This was a full, graded inspection; six inspectors visited the school over two days and investigated all aspects of provision. It was a rigorous process; the inspection team observed lessons, studied data, met with school leaders, spoke with students and staff, and drew on feedback from parents.

The report captures some long-held strengths of the school:

- Our ambitious, inclusive ethos
- The importance placed on diversity and the centrality of relationships
- The pride staff have in working here, and the pride students have in studying here

The report also acts to highlight and celebrate post-pandemic work on safeguarding, behaviour and culture, personal development and curriculum design. In doing so, it provides us with a highly encouraging platform for future progress.

Ofsted have been in the news a lot recently, and I think it important to recognise:

- The efforts of staff in what is a stressful and demanding process

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- The efforts of inspectors in conducting the inspection in a sensitive, empathetic manner

The report highlighted two areas for improvement – linked to activity selection in some lessons and student engagement with our wide extra-curricular offer – that reflected our own self-evaluation. We have plans in place to address these priorities over the coming months.
