Year 11 Examinations, Study Arrangements and End of Year Information

Dear Parent/ Carer

As summer examinations continue, I am writing to inform you of the arrangements for the remainder of the examination season and for end of the school year for our current Year 11.

Examination Arrangements from Wednesday 7 June 2017

Students are expected to be in school for all their examinations and for any lessons for which they still have an examination to sit. Their subject teachers will be in lessons ready to help with revision and last minute preparation. Students are expected to attend both examinations and lessons in full school uniform.

Please ensure students arrive to school in plenty of time for their examinations; by **0830 for morning examinations** and by **1300 for afternoon examinations**.

However, from **Wednesday 7 June** if a student does **not** have an examination or lesson they will be dismissed from the school site to return home to study independently. If they would prefer to study at school the Dining Room or alternative will be available for **quiet study only**, if students are not using it they will be expected to leave the school site and return home. The usual **pre-morning examination study routines** in the Dining Room are still in place as are **afterschool and Saturday revision** until further notice.

Please may I make you aware students still have important examinations to complete, in a number of subjects, including:

Thursday 8 June, (0900): GCSE Mathematics Paper 2 Monday 12 June, (0900): GCSE English Language Paper 2 Tuesday 13 June, (0900): GCSE Mathematics Paper 3

These subjects have lessons on Wednesday 7 June, Period 3 (English) and Period 4 (Mathematics) and Friday 9 June, Periods 3&4 (English) and P5 (Mathematics).

Students attending school outside of examination or lesson time should tick their name off at reception on the lists provided if entering school to study. Normal lunch arrangements will be in place for students in school sitting an afternoon examination.



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Year 11 Graduation Assembly - Friday 30 June (14:00) (arrival from 13:30)

We look forward to welcoming back all Year 11 students and parents/ carers who wish to attend for a **Year 11 Graduation Assembly** which will start **promptly at 1400**, arrival from 1330, and will last approximately 1 hour. All students are expected in **full school uniform** for the assembly and may be turned away if this is not the case. This is the last formal opportunity for Year 11 to be gathered together to celebrate the last five years at Hampstead.

Year 11 Prom – Friday 30 June at the Crown Hotel, Cricklewood (starts at 1900)

For those attending, **entrance is by ticket only**. If these have not already been purchased they can still be before Monday 12 June from Ms Hurley at the cost of £36. This includes entrance to the venue, buffet meal with soft drinks and DJ. Extra soft drinks may be purchased from the venue.

The address of the venue is stated on the ticket and **arrival will be from 1845** to start promptly at 1900. We look forward to seeing students return after the Graduation Assembly, earlier in the day, for this evening event. **Final dismissal** from the venue will be at **2330**.

Textbook and Resources collection

Students need to ensure that **all books**, **study texts or revision guides** given to them or any outstanding library loans are returned. Examinations certificates cannot be issued unless/ until all textbooks are returned and furthermore Prom tickets can be withheld until students have done so. Please bring back any outstanding book resources to Ms Hurley's/ Dr Hadley's office with the completed enclosed book return form (at the end of this letter), signed off by a representative of each faculty once examinations in those subjects are completed. Please complete this task by the Graduation Assembly/ book return day of 30th June. At the graduation, each faculty will have a facility to collect your books. Should any books remain outstanding, faculties may seek recompense for them. If you have any questions regarding the return of particular books please contact the relevant faculty.
