


Haberdashers Askes Boys School moves from Hoxton to what is now the West Block on Westbere Road.










The Headmaster Mr. Wagstaff is third from the left in the middle row. Over 100 boys from the school lost their lives in the conflict



Restraint combined with excitement

John Stillman was blunt enough to ask me to look at the new building at Hampstead School, Westbere Road, I had seen the report of the opening by Christopher Chataway on October 17 in the Ham & High and had noted, as he had with justifiable chagrin, that the architects had not been mentioned.

When Haberdashers' Aske's School moved to Elstree, the GLC took over the existing buildings, a rather dour Victorian block, with a nondescript extension and a science block in the faceless thirties style, and commissioned Stillman and Eastwick-Field to design extensions and improvements to provide a school for some 1,350 pupils of which at present about 850 occupy the premises completed two years ago.

The problem was not an easy one, nor has it been helped by a degree of vandalism in the early stages of occupation. The Headmaster's laudable aim is to create what he described as a compatible society and the atmosphere






