Dear Parent/Carer,

I'm writing to ask you to consider whether you would like your child to continue with Core PE lessons until their GCSE exams later this summer. We recognise that PE lessons are very important for your child's physical and mental wellbeing and can support to alleviate stress in the lead up to their public exams. However, we also recognise that this is a busy time for students and they may wish to spend more of their time in school preparing for the upcoming GCSEs through additional revision activities.

If students choose to withdraw from Core PE lessons, they will join organised revision classes. During these *revision* lessons, students will be supervised by a teacher and they will complete revision activities directed by Heads of Faculty across the different subject areas. If students choose to withdraw from Core PE they will remain in revision lessons for the rest of the year and will not be able to return to PE lessons.
