## Easter Study School Programme - Monday 12 to Friday 16 April 2021

I am writing to ask for your continued support at this important time for our students as they approach the end of their Key Stage 4 (KS4) courses. As you will know, this summer's examination series has been cancelled and replaced by teacher assessed grades. However, our students still have a vitally important half term ahead of them when we return after Easter.

There will be *opportunity to improve* assessments throughout the half term in all subjects, as detailed to students over the last couple of weeks, and further information will be provided early in the new term. Students can still greatly influence the final grades submitted and preparation for these assessments is essential to maximise their KS4 outcomes and guarantee pathways for future progression.

To this end, there is a variety of provision available to our students over the Easter break. Teachers will set targeted and specific home learning either via SatchelOne or through assignments set on Microsoft Teams for classes, as was done in the recent lockdown period. Further to this, and detailed more fully below, some **remote "live" lessons** will be delivered over the Easter period for certain subjects on certain days. These sessions will subsequently be streamed in case any access issues are encountered when delivered. Similarly, there are a limited number of **in-school/ on-site lessons** for some subjects during the second full week of the holiday, again, detailed below. Alongside this, there are also extensive, supervised National Tutoring Programme (NTP) sessions on site for an already identified group of students. A separate letter has been distributed to the relevant students detailing these requirements in the last couple of days.

Any in school sessions (NTP or otherwise) will run from **1000 to 1400** with suitable supervised breaks. There is **no lunch service** available. If students are attending, we advise they bring a snack/s to have at any break period. If students leave the site they will not be re-admitted. There is **no charge** to attend. Student should arrive at the south (KS4) gate at the start of the session where they will be directed to the appropriate room or part of the school. A register will be taken on arrival and throughout the day. Students must remain in the areas of the school where sessions are taking place and will be supervised at all times. This is mainly due to health and safety reasons because some site work will be taking place. Care and attention will be needed in moving around the site and **appropriate sensible behaviour and conduct** is expected at all times. Failure to show this expected level of behaviour will result in students being asked to leave.
