



Summer 2021 – High Expectations

The start of the final half term acts as an opportune time to reset expectations, some of which have not been enforced consistently due to the pressures created by changing government guidelines. The majority of students adhere to these standards every day, but we still ask that everyone makes sure they understand these guidelines.

We will be applying these standards with great consistency when you return to school – following our two rearranged INSET days – on Wednesday 9 June.



Mobile Phones

Students are allowed to bring a mobile phone and air pods / ear phones to school, but they cannot be seen or heard whilst on the school site.

If a mobile phone is seen or heard by a member of staff it will be confiscated and stored in the school reception area.

If a student follows instructions immediately it will be returned to them at the end of the school day. If the student does not follow the instruction immediately the phone will be kept by the school for 24 hours or returned to parents / carers.



Punctuality to school

All students in Years 7 to 11 must be on the school site before 0840.

From Wednesday June 9, any student arriving after 0840 will have to hand in their mobile phone (or another item of value) at the school gate. This will be returned to them when they sit a fifteen-minute late detention at break time.



Uniform

We have made some changes to support families at a difficult time in terms of finances.

- 1) Blazers are now optional – students must wear a blazer AND/OR a school jumper AND/OR a school cardigan.**
- 2) Completely plain black trainers are permitted, alongside black formal shoes.**

We will review these changes at the end of the summer term.



Although we are relaxing some elements of the uniform policy, all other elements will be strictly enforced.

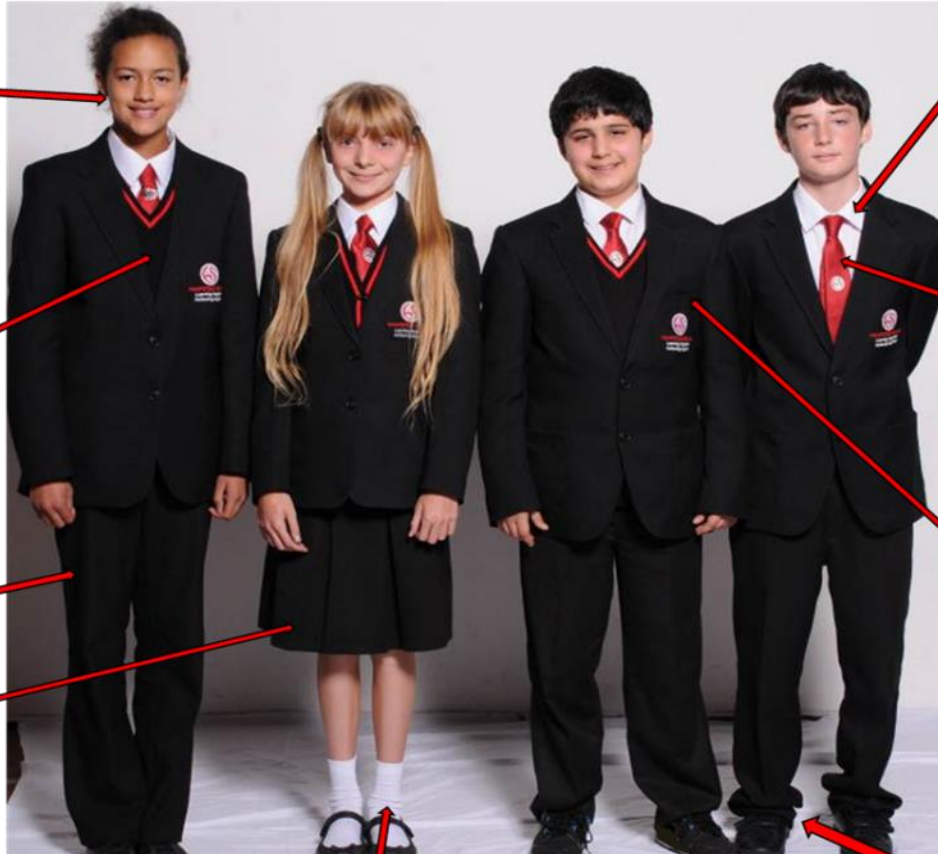
Small plain stud earrings, 1 in each ear (optional)

Hampstead School jumper / cardigan (optional)

Black, full length, straight leg, formal school trousers

Knee length, black school skirt

Plain black or natural colour tights
Plain black or white ankle length socks



White school shirt with the top button done up, tucked in

School tie with logo showing. Tie knot to top button of the shirt (essential)

Hampstead School blazer
OR
Hampstead School jumper
OR Hampstead School cardigan

Completely plain black flat **shoes or trainers**, no coloured laces or soles & no logos



PE kit also needs to be more consistent...

On the day that they have practical PE, all students must wear:

- Plain black shorts / tracksuit bottoms / leggings / knee length cycling shorts (no logos or designs)
- Red Hampstead School polo shirt with school logo
- White socks
- Suitable sports trainers

Students studying dance in Year 10 or 11 may choose to wear a plain black long sleeve top and bring suitable dance shoes or grip socks.

Hooded sweatshirts, tracksuit tops and tracksuit bottoms featuring designs are not allowed.
