Dear Parents / Carers,

Following my letter yesterday, we have an increasing number of staff required to follow Public Health (England) advice on self-isolation. I have to balance high levels of absence with ensuring the safety of students in school.

Regrettably, I have decided to partially close the school for Year 10 for the remainder of this week. The school will be closed for students in Year 10 from today. Any students in Year 10 who arrive in school will be sent home.

We will remain open for other Years. However, any student who is displaying symptoms or is living with someone displaying symptoms (temperature and/or persistent cough) must remain at home for the next 14 days.

I will update you as the situation develops.

Once again, can I ask that you do not contact the school with general enquiries about the school's response to Coronavirus Covid-19.

We continue to monitor the situation very closely, whilst running the school. We act on guidance from Camden, the Department for Education and Public Health (England), and I will continue to update you on our response
