Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you managed to have a safe and restful weekend following our first week of online learning.

By now, I trust that all students will have had a telephone conversation with their tutor, or similar.

Please note that whilst we are trying to call every student weekly, incoming telephone numbers must be withheld. If you receive a "Private Number" or "Number Withheld" call, please do answer as it is likely to be from your child's form tutor.

Staff in school are in regular contact with each other, sharing information through videoconferencing and other social media applications. We are also in regular contact with broader agencies within Camden and our resident boroughs.

I have been impressed with the engagement from the large majority of students, moving to this new way of working and communicating. However, a few students are still having difficulty accessing RM Unify which is the portal to Show My Homework, SENECA Learning, SAM Learning.

Please can you check that your child is able to log on, separately from the parental app that you may have.

Your child needs to

- Follow the Outlook web access tile on RMUnify to log in to their school email or use the link on the 'contact us' page on the school website.
- Your child's password for their email and for RMUnify is the same as the one they use to log in to the school computers.
