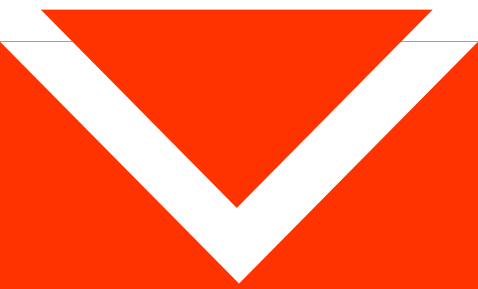


THE 10 TIMES

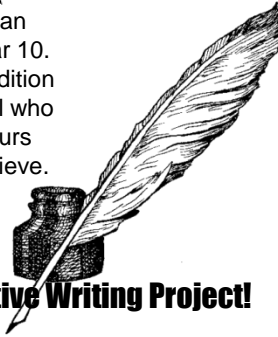

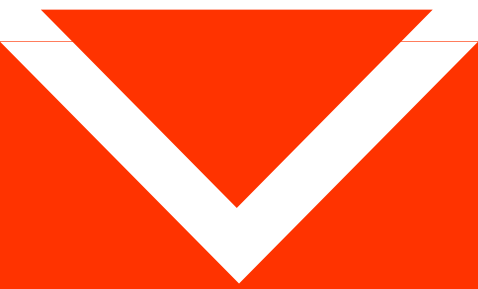

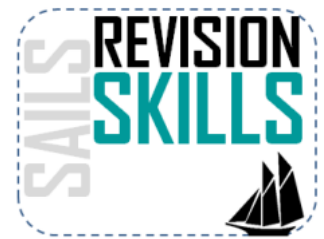
They will 'showcase' their work in an exhibition at The British Museum where they can invite family and friends. This project is in its third year of running.

Student Investor Challenge

Year 10 goes through to semi-finals!

The Student Investor Challenge is a UK wide investment game for students aged 16-18. The competition involves teams investing a virtual £100,000 on the London Stock Exchange. They need to keep their portfolios healthy by following the ups and downs of the market, judging when to buy and sell in order to make a profit.

This year, there were 4856 teams involved in the first round and 500 were selected to go through to semi-finals. Hampstead School had two teams going through – one of which was 'Team 5' - team of four boys from year 10: Edison Arifi, Munasar Mohamed, Bilal Boudchar Chokoud, Saad Shah! A fantastic achievement as this was a tough year for the markets, making it even more competitive!
